- Established in 2007 by Finnish municipalities and companies in need of stable, CO2 free and affordable energy
- Consumer driven private investment; Finland does not subsidize nuclear power
- Supports Finland's and EU's energy and climate objectives: less emissions, less imports, more competitiveness
- Location: greenfield site in Pyhäjoki, Northern Finland
- Technology of choice: Rosatom AES-2006, the latest development step of VVER units
- Operational: 2024
